- 3D modeling in both Sketchup and ArchiCAD, and 2D drafting in AutoCAD under supervision of Interior Design Director.

- Producing drawings for architectural construction documents. This includes lighting layouts, reflected ceiling plans, and coordinating between CAD and Sketchup.

- Managing our design assistants and drafters to assist on projects. This includes quote requests for plumbing, appliances, doors and windows, etc as well as data entry for interior schedules.
